

**From Richmond:** Take I-64 East towards Williamsburg. Take Exit 234 for VA-199/State Route 646 toward Lightfoot. Merge onto VA-199 E and continue for 8 miles to VA-31 S/Jamestown Road. Turn right onto VA-31 S/Jamestown Road. Continue to follow Jamestown Road for 3.9 miles. Turn left on the Colonial Parkway and turn left at the Marina sign.

From Norfolk: Take I-64 West towards Williamsburg. Take Exit 242A, towards Williamsburg/Jamestown. Follow VA-199 for 5.4 miles to VA-31S/Jamestown Road. Turn left onto VA-31 S/Jamestown Road. Continue to follow Jamestown Road for 3.9 miles. Turn left on the Colonial Parkway and turn left at the Marina sign.

**Park Amenities:** Facilities at this park include a boat ramp, picnic shelter, a small store and access to the Virginia Capital Trail. Canoe, kayak and stand up paddleboard rentals are also available. Other privately owned amenities include thee Billsburg Brewery, Jamestown Discovery Boat Tours and Hampton Marine Services. # Bikes, Parks, Scenery & FUN

What awaits riders of the 20th Annual Park to Park Bicycle Tour?

Close-up views of our award-winning County parks, tree-lined country roads, fresh air, a taste of the Virginia Capital Trail and camaraderie with fellow biking enthusiasts, not to mention Live music featuring The People Collection, swimming, lunch and fun!

This is a great venue for less-experienced riders. The rides are mostly flat to gently rolling, with some hills along the way (30 and 50-mile rides include some traveling on roads). Four ride options are available to suit bikers of all levels and abilities, with each route starting and ending at the James City County Marina.

**Family Ride option:** Bike the Virginia Capital Trail as much or as little as you prefer, ending back at the James City County Marina for lunch and live music beginning at 11:30 a.m. (no specific rest stops for this option).

**15-Mile Ride option:** Enjoy views from the Virginia Capital Trail as you start from an informative kiosk near Jamestown Settlement—then return to the James City County Marina for lunch and live music. (Rest stop and restrooms available at Virginia Chickahominy Riverfront Park). Map and cue sheet provided.

<u>30-Mile Ride option</u>: Travel most of the 15-mile route with the addition of a few more country roads and scenic parks including Freedom Park, Veterans Park (formerly Mid County) and the Powhatan Creek Trail —then back to the James City County Marina for lunch and live music. Plenty of miles on this option to stretch out and relax. (Rest stops and restrooms available at Chickahominy Riverfront Park, Freedom Park and Veterans Park). Map and cue sheet provided.

### 50-Mile/Half Century Ride option:

Challenge yourself to the ultimate Park to Park experience, traveling most of the 15 and 30-mile routes and also visiting Little Creek Reservoir Park and Upper County Park—then back to the James City County Marina for lunch and live music. (Rest stops and restrooms available at Freedom Park, Little Creek Reservoir Park, Upper County Park and Veterans Park; map and cue sheet provided).

#### **Registration**:

Return the registration form by June 29 or register the day of the event (registration for 30/50 mile begins at 8 a.m., registration for Family/15 mile begins at 9:30 a.m.). Families are encouraged to attend; however, anyone under 18 must have a parent or guardian present on the ride. Preregistration is \$15 for 50-mile ride or \$20 onsite; \$10 for 30-mile ride or \$15 onsite; or \$5 for Family/15-mile ride or \$10 onsite. Children 9 and younger are free, and must be on a tandem bike or trailer.

### **Bicycles:**

Please make sure your bike is in good working order. We strongly recommend that you have your local bike shop perform a pre-ride safety check.
